Internal Reinforcement and Fiber Management

Inside the splice box, splice cassettes and trays are used to organize fibers, maintain bend radius, and prevent microbending or macrobending that can degrade signal quality . Reinforcement strategies include:

- Strain relief brackets or clamps to secure incoming and outgoing cables, reducing stress on splices.
- Removable splice trays that allow technicians to access fibers without disturbing...
