Current Infrastructure and Coverage

As of 2026, Mali's fiber optic infrastructure covers approximately 35% of the country, reflecting steady growth driven by both government initiatives and private sector participation. Internet penetration stands at around 28%, with an average broadband speed of 25 Mbps, supporting digital services, e-commerce, and mobile internet usage among roughly 7.5 million users. The sector is experiencing an annual growth rate of 12%, highlighting increasing adoption, particularly among youth and entrepreneurs, though rural accessibility and high costs remain challenges for rapid expansion .

Government Initiatives

The Malian government has launched a major project to extend the national fiber optic network, awarding a \$117.3 million contract to China International Telecommunication Construction Corporation. This project targets regions including Mopti, Koro, Tombouctou, Gao, Ansongo, and Labenzaga, with an estimated duration of 24 months. The initiative is part of Mali's broader digital transformation agenda, aiming to modernize administration, foster startups, and enhance economic development while reducing internet costs and improving service quality .
