A fiber optic pigtail is a short fiber cable with a factory-terminated connector on one end and bare fiber on the other, designed for splicing into a larger fiber network.

What is a Fiber Optic Pigtail?

A fiber optic pigtail is a short length of optical fiber, typically 0.5 to 2 meters long, with a factory-installed connector on one end and a bare fiber on the other. The connector end is polished and tested under factory conditions to ensure low insertion loss and high return loss, while the bare fiber end is intended for fusion or mechanical splicing to a main fiber optic cable in the field. This design allows for reliable, high-performance terminations without the need for field-installed connectors, which are slower and less precise.

Differences Between Pigtails and Patch Cords

- Pigtail: Connector on one end, bare fiber on the other; used for splicing into bulk fiber cables.
- Patch Cord: Connectors on both ends; used for connecting equipment, patch panels, or transceivers. A patch cord can sometimes be cut to create two pigtails, but pigtails are generally preferred for field splicing because the bare end allows for precise, low-loss connections.
