Connector-Based Connections

Fiber optic connectors are mechanical devices that align and join optical fibers, allowing light to pass through with minimal loss. Common connector types for socket panels include:

- SC (Subscriber Connector): Square-shaped, push-pull mechanism, widely used in FTTH and data centers. SC/APC variants reduce reflection loss, critical for GPON networks .
- LC (Lucent Connector): Miniaturized version of SC with a 1.25mm ferrule, ideal for high-density panels. Uses a latch mechanism for secure connections .
- FC (Ferrule Connector): Threaded screw mechanism, often used in telecom and high-vibration environments .
- ST (Straight Tip): Bayonet twist-lock mechanism, common in legacy networks .

Installation Steps for Connectors

- Preparation: Gather tools such as fiber strippers, cleaver, crimping pliers, UV glue or epoxy, and a UV lamp .
- Fiber Inspection: Check for damage, avoid kinks or bends.
- Insert Boot and Glue: Place the connector boot on the fiber, inject glue into the fer...
