SC/APC cold connectors are generally considered better than SC/UPC for most modern FTTH and PON applications due to their superior return loss and low back reflection.

Overview of Cold Connectors

Fiber optic cold connectors, also known as mechanical splice or fast connectors, allow field termination of fiber cables without a fusion splicer. They use pre-installed index-matching gel or mechanical alignment to connect the bare fiber to a short fiber stub inside the connector, enabling optical signal transmission. Cold connectors are ideal for quick installations, emergency repairs, and small-scale deployments because they reduce installation time and tool costs compared to fusion splicing .

SC/APC vs SC/UPC

- SC/APC (Angled Physical Contact): Features an 8-degree angled endface polish, providing return loss $\geq 60\text{dB}$, which minimizes back reflection. This makes SC/APC connectors the standard choice for GPON, EPON, and CATV networks, where low back reflection is critical for maintaining signal quality . The green housing color follows industry standards for APC connectors.
- SC/UPC (Ultra Physical Contact): Uses a flat polish with return loss $\geq 50\text{dB}$. While still effective, SC/UPC connectors are more prone to back reflection, making them less suitable for high-precision PON or RF video applications
