Fiber optic splice closures are protective enclosures that house fiber splices and connectors, safeguarding them from environmental factors while allowing organized cable management . Blue connectors are often installed in these closures to facilitate quick connection and disconnection without splicing, which is especially useful in maintenance, network upgrades, or high-density deployments . Closures can accommodate multiple cables and fibers, and the color coding helps technicians identify connector types and polish standards quickly .
