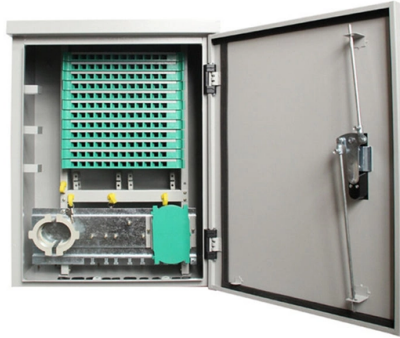


Fiber optic pigtail signal

What is a Fiber Optic Pigtail?

A fiber optic pigtail is a short length of optical fiber, typically 0.5 to 2 meters, with a factory-installed connector on one end and a bare fiber on the other. The connector end plugs into network equipment, patch panels, or transceivers, while the bare fiber end is designed for fusion or mechanical splicing to the main fiber cable in the field . This setup ensures high signal integrity, as factory-terminated connectors provide low insertion loss and high return loss compared to field-installed connectors .
