- SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable): Supports speeds up to 1 Gbps, suitable for standard fiber links.
- SFP+ (Enhanced SFP): Supports 10 Gbps connections, commonly used for high-throughput aggregation links.
- SFP28: Supports 25 Gbps, providing higher bandwidth for modern data center or backbone networks. These ports allow modularity, meaning you can insert different transceivers depending on the required distance and fiber type (single-mode or multi-mode).
