

Fiber optic to Ethernet cable cascaded routers

You can connect a fiber optic internet line to a router via an ONT and then cascade additional routers using Ethernet cables to expand your network.

Step 1: Connect Fiber Optic Cable to Router

- Install the Optical Network Terminal (ONT): Your ISP typically provides an ONT, which converts the incoming fiber optic light signals into electrical signals compatible with standard networking equipment ().
- Connect the Fiber Cable: Plug the fiber optic cable from the wall outlet into the ONT's designated port. Ensure the connection is secure to avoid signal degradation ().
- Link ONT to Router: Use a high-quality Ethernet cable (Cat6a or higher) to connect the ONT's Ethernet/LAN port to your router's WAN port. This allows your router to receive the converted signal ().
- Power On Devices: Turn on the ONT first, wait for the status lights to stabilize, then power on your router. Access the router's web interface (commonly 192.168.0.1 or 192.168.1.1) to configure network settings and enable Quality of Service (QoS) if needed ().

Step 2: Cascade Additional Routers via Ethernet

- Determine Primary and Secondary Routers: The router connected directly to the ONT is the primary router. Secondary routers will connect through Ethernet to extend the network ().
- Choose Connection Type: Decide between LAN-to-LAN (same network, seamless d...
