Key International Standards

ITU-T Standards

- G.652: Defines single-mode fiber optimized for 1310 nm with low attenuation, widely used in backbone and access networks, including FTTH deployments .
- G.655: Specifies non-zero dispersion-shifted fiber for long-haul and metro networks.
- G.657: Designed for last-mile and indoor applications, supporting tight bends and compact routing, making it ideal for FTTH installations . IEC Standards
- IEC 60793: Covers physical and optical performance of single-mode and multimode fibers, including attenuation limits and dimensional tolerances .
- IEC 60794: Defines fiber optic cable construction, mechanical performance, and environmental resistance, ensuring durability in indoor, outdoor, and universal cable designs . TIA and ISO/IEC Standards
- TIA-568.3-D: Provides performance requirements and installation guidelines for optical fiber cabling systems in enterprise, campus, and data center environments .
- ISO/IEC 11801: Offers international recommendations for generic cabling systems, including fiber optic links, ensuring interoperability and long-term reliability .

- Focuses on mechanical and environmental reliability of fiber optic cables, widely referenced for procurement and type testing in telecom networks
