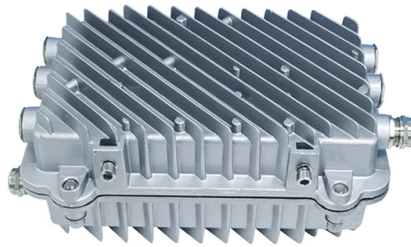


Function of Gigabit Optical Ports on Switches

Function and Flexibility

A gigabit optical port, typically an SFP (Small Form-Factor Pluggable) port, is a modular interface on a switch that accepts transceiver modules for either fiber optic or copper connections . This allows a single switch to adapt to different media types and transmission distances without replacing the hardware . Optical SFP modules are particularly useful for connecting switches across long distances, such as between buildings or data center racks, where copper Ethernet cables would be limited by distance and signal degradation .

Advantages Over Standard Ports

Unlike fixed RJ45 ports, which are limited to copper connections and shorter distances (typically up to 100 meters), gigabit optical ports can support multimode or single-mode fiber, BiDi optics, and long-range modules up to 150 km . This makes them ideal for enterprise networks, data centers, and high-traffic environments where high bandwidth, low latency, and reliable connectivity are critical .
