Article Overview

Ghana's fiber optic network is a combination of government-led and private sector initiatives, providing nationwide connectivity and cross-border links to support digital transformation and economic growth.

Government-Led Fiber Projects

The Eastern Corridor Fiber Optic Backbone is a major government initiative aimed at improving connectivity in underserved regions of Ghana. Implemented by the Ministry of Communications with Alcatel-Lucent Denmark as the vendor, this project spans from Ho to Bawku, branching at Yendi to Tamale, covering 27 districts and towns. It includes a secondary data center in Kumasi, complements the primary data center in Accra, and provides managed services for government institutions. The network is designed with a 16x10G capacity and is expected to attract investment, improve access to information, support telemedicine, and reduce rural-urban migration through job creation, with a total project cost of €38 million funded via a Danish loan facility (Ministry of Communications) . The Government of Ghana has also approved a “Dig Once Policy”, integrating fiber-optic ducts and access chambers into all new road construction projects. This policy reduces the cost and time for telecom operators to deploy networks, minimizes service interruptions caused by roadworks, and aligns with the National Broadband Strategy and Digital Economy Policy (2024) .
