

Height requirements for electrical distribution boxes



Article Overview

The recommended height for electrical distribution boxes is generally between 1.0 and 1.8 meters (3.3 to 5.9 feet) from the floor, with 1.3 to 1.5 meters being ideal for accessibility and safety.

Residential Installation

For homes, distribution boxes or consumer units are typically installed between 1.0 and 1.8 meters from the floor, with 1.3 meters suggested for elderly or handicapped users to ensure easy access without bending or stretching excessively . Mounting at this height also protects the box from accidental water spills or impacts . A height of around 1.5 meters is commonly used in modern residential installations for convenience and safety .

Industrial Installation

In industrial settings, the height may vary depending on equipment and space constraints. Distribution boards with an IP54 protection rating are often mounted with a maximum height of 1.2 meters for the panel itself, while ensuring adequate working space around the panel for maintenance . Clearance and accessibility are critical, and panels should be installed in dry, ventilated areas away from water or dust .
