A Home Telecom Leased Line Access Switch is the network device that connects a leased line to your home or business network, enabling dedicated, high-speed, symmetrical internet access.

What is a Leased Line?

A leased line is a dedicated, point-to-point internet connection that provides uncontended, symmetrical bandwidth with full-duplex traffic, meaning upload and download speeds are equal and consistent . Unlike broadband, which is shared among multiple users, a leased line ensures reliable performance, making it ideal for applications like VoIP, cloud services, online sales, and large file transfers . Leased lines can be delivered over fiber-optic cables (Ethernet Access Direct) or, in some cases, copper pairs (Ethernet in the First Mile) depending on availability .

Role of the Access Switch

The access switch in a leased line setup acts as the interface between the service provider's network and your local network. In fiber-based connections, the Optical Network Terminal (ONT) or similar device terminates the fiber at your premises. From there, the access switch or router distributes the connection to your home or business devices, such as computers, servers, or VoIP phones . It ensures full-duplex data transmission, manages traffic, and may provide additional features like VLAN segmentation, routing, or security services.
