Distribution Box Selection and Placement

Choose a distribution box suitable for the environment and load capacity. Indoor boxes can be plastic or steel, while outdoor or industrial boxes require higher IP/NEMA ratings for protection against dust and moisture (). Install the box in a dry, accessible area, typically around 1.5 meters above the floor, with adequate ventilation ().

Components Overview

A typical distribution box includes:

- Main Breaker or Main Isolator: Disconnects power for the entire system ().
- Busbars: Distribute incoming power to branch breakers ().
- Neutral Bar (N): Collects return conductors for balanced operation ().
- Earth/Ground Bar (PE): Provides a safe path for fault currents ().
- Branch Circuit Breakers: Protect individual circuits such as lighting, sockets, or motors ()....
