

How high is the beam above the opening of the distribution box



Article Overview

The bottom of a distribution box is typically installed 1.5 to 1.8 meters above the floor, ensuring sufficient clearance above the opening for safe operation and maintenance.

Recommended Installation Height

For most residential and industrial installations, the bottom edge of the distribution box is mounted between 1.5 meters and 1.8 meters (approximately 4 ft 11 in to 5 ft 11 in) above the floor . This height allows easy access for operation, inspection, and maintenance while keeping the box out of reach of children in homes .

Clearance Above the Box

The beam or structural element above the distribution box should provide enough clearance to allow safe access to the panel and its breakers. While specific codes may not define an exact distance from the beam to the box, general practice and NEC guidelines emphasize that no obstructions should block the working space in front of the panel, and the top of the panel should not exceed 6 feet 7 inches (2 meters) from the floor for accessibility . This ensures that the circuit breakers and switches are reachable without strain.
