

How long should the wires be when making a distribution box



Article Overview

At least 6 inches of free conductor should be left inside a distribution box, with an additional 3 inches extending outside the box if the opening is smaller than 8 inches.

Minimum Wire Length Inside the Box

For any outlet, junction, or switch point where a connection or splice will be made, a minimum of 6 inches (152 mm) of free conductor must be left inside the box. This length is measured from the point where the wire exits the cable sheath or raceway inside the box. This ensures that electricians have enough slack to safely strip, bend, and connect wires to devices or splicing connectors without tension or risk of damage to the conductor .

Extension Beyond the Box Opening

If the box opening is less than 8 inches (200 mm) in any dimension, each conductor must extend at least 3 inches (75 mm) outside the box. This additional length provides sufficient room to make clean, accessible splices or terminations, especially in compact boxes where space is limited .

Practical Considerations

- Leaving the correct wire length prevents strained connections, reduces the risk of overheating, and ensures compliance with electrical codes
