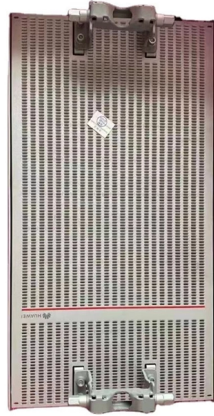


How many fiber optic cable jumps

- Simplex jumpers: Single fiber for unidirectional transmission.
- Duplex jumpers: Two fibers for bidirectional communication .
- Connector types: LC, SC, ST, and MTP/MPO connectors are used depending on the equipment and network requirements .
