

How many optical ports does an optical module have

Standard Duplex Modules

Typical optical modules, such as SFP, SFP+, and SFP28, are designed for duplex communication, meaning they have two fiber ports: one for transmitting (TX) and one for receiving (RX) signals. These ports are usually side-by-side and connect to separate fibers, allowing simultaneous bidirectional data transmission over two strands of fiber optic cable .

Single-Fiber (BiDi) Modules

Some optical modules, known as bidirectional (BiDi) modules, use a single fiber port to handle both transmit and receive signals. This is achieved by using different wavelengths for each direction, which allows data to flow in both directions over a single fiber strand. BiDi modules are commonly used in scenarios where fiber availability is limited, such as in FTTH (Fiber to the Home) deployments .
