Power and Performance

Single-mode fiber (SMF) cables have a very small core diameter of about 8-10 microns, allowing only a single light path to propagate. This design minimizes modal dispersion, enabling high-bandwidth transmission over long distances. Typical specifications include:

- OS1 cables: Maximum attenuation of 0.4 dB/km at 1310 nm and 0.3 dB/km at 1550 nm, supporting distances up to 10 km at speeds up to 10 Gbps .
- OS2 cables: Maximum attenuation of 0.3 dB/km at 1310-1550 nm, supporting distances up to 40 km at 10 Gbps .
- Bandwidth: OS1 offers 200 MHz·km at 1310 nm, while OS2 provides 500 MHz·km at 1310 nm .
- Power handling: Single-mode fibers can carry optical signals over multiple miles without repeaters, making them ideal for backbone and long-haul networks . The focused light path allows efficient signal transmission with minimal amplification, which is critical for high-speed, long-distance communication.
