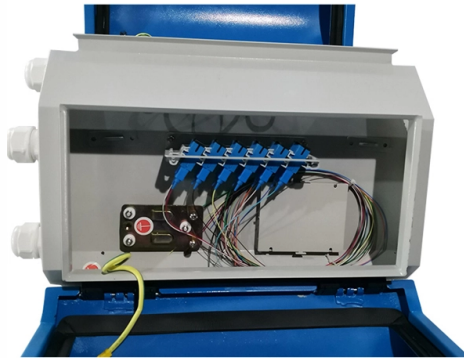


How much power does a Canadian indoor electrical distribution box have



Overview

In Canadian homes this is most commonly 100A or 200A. Slots (spaces) — the number of physical positions the panel has for breakers. A full panel with no free, code-compliant spaces limits what you can add without changes. Advancements in circuit breaker technology, especially the 200-amp circuit breaker panel size, are crucial in modern construction due to increasing electrical demands from various appliances and systems since the 1980s.
