

How to connect a fiber optic coupler 2-in-1

3. Align the Connectors: Insert the fiber connectors into the coupler ports, ensuring that the ferrules are properly aligned with the internal alignment sleeve. Proper alignment is crucial for efficient light transmission and minimal insertion loss .
4. Secure the Connection: Push the connectors gently but firmly into the coupler. Some couplers may include latches or locking mechanisms to hold the connectors in place. Avoid excessive force to prevent damage to the fiber or coupler .
5. Test the Connection: After connecting, perform a visual inspection and test the optical signal using a fiber optic power meter or optical time-domain reflectometer (OTDR). This ensures that the connection is stable and that the signal is transmitted efficiently without significant loss .
