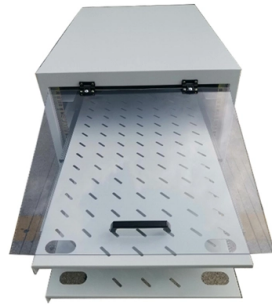


How to connect a fiber optic module to a pigtail
