

How to connect a pigtail level 1



Article Overview

To connect a pigtail, cut a short wire matching the circuit gauge, strip the ends, twist it with the existing wires using a wire nut, and attach the free end to the device terminal.

Step-by-Step Guide

1. Safety First Turn off the power at the breaker and verify that the circuit is de-energized using a non-contact voltage tester to prevent electric shock (). 2. Gather Tools and Materials You will need:

- Wire strippers
 - Lineman's pliers
 - Wire nuts (appropriate size)
 - Screwdriver
 - Needle-nose pliers (optional for looping wires)
 - Non-contact voltage tester
 - Pigtail wire (same gauge and color as the circuit, minimum 6 inches) ().
3. Prepare the Wires Cut the pigtail wire to 6-8 inches. Strip about $\frac{1}{2}$ to $\frac{3}{4}$ inch of insulation from both ends of the pigtail and the existing circuit wires (). 4. Twist the Wires Together Align the stripped ends of the existing wires (hot, neutral, or ground) with the pigtail wire. Twist them together clockwise using lineman's pliers until the wire nut is tight and fully covers the exposed copper (). 5. Attach the Pigtail to the Device Form a small loop at the free end of the pigtail wire and attach it to the corresponding screw terminal on the device (hot to brass, neutral to silver, ground to green or bare copper). Loop the wire clockwise around the screw for a secure connection (). 6. Te...
