

How to connect cables from cable trays

Connecting cables to cable trays requires proper planning, secure mounting, and the use of appropriate connectors to ensure safety, stability, and compliance with electrical codes.

Step 1: Plan the Route

Before installation, mark the cable tray path on walls, ceilings, or floors using a chalk line or laser level. Consider clearance, load capacity, cable separation, and any bends, tees, or elevation changes along the route . Proper planning prevents interference with other systems and ensures smooth cable routing.

Step 2: Select the Right Tray and Supports

Choose the appropriate tray type—ladder, perforated, or solid-bottom—based on cable type, load, and ventilation needs . Ladder trays are ideal for large power cables, while ventilated troughs support smaller control cables. Install supports (wall brackets or ceiling suspension) at recommended intervals, typically 1.5 to 3 meters, to prevent sagging .

Step 3: Prepare and Join Tray Sections

Measure and cut tray sections to fit the route. Deburr edges to prevent cable damage . Join sections using splice plates, bolted connections, clamps, or quick-connect systems depending on the tray type and manufacturer . Splice plates are flat metal plates bolted to tray ends for strong, straight-line connections, while L, T, or cross-s...
