

How to connect fiber optic cables to an optical cable switch

Fiber optic cables connect to an optical switch via compatible transceiver modules (SFP, SFP+, QSFP, etc.), ensuring the correct fiber type and port configuration for reliable high-speed data transmission.

Step 1: Identify the Switch and Ports

Determine the type of optical switch you are using and the available ports. Common port types include SFP (1 Gbps), SFP+ (10 Gbps), QSFP+ (40 Gbps), and QSFP28 (100 Gbps). The port type dictates the compatible transceiver module you need to use . Some switches have combo ports, where an RJ45 copper port shares a logical connection with an optical port, so only one can be active at a time .

Step 2: Select the Appropriate Transceiver Module

Choose a transceiver module compatible with both the switch port and the fiber optic cable type:

- Single-mode fiber (SMF): Suitable for long-distance connections (kilometers), typically using 1310nm or 1550nm wavelength.
- Multi-mode fiber (MMF): Suitable for short-distance connections (hundreds of meters), typically using 850nm wavelength . Insert the SFP/SFP+ module into the corresponding switch port. These modules are usually hot-swappable, so the switch does not need to be powered down
