

How to connect the end plug of a fiber optic sensor amplifier



Article Overview

To connect the end plug of a fiber optic sensor amplifier, insert the fiber cables into the correct inlets, secure them with the fiber lock lever, and install optional end plates if the amplifier is part of a cascade.

Step-by-Step Instructions

- Power Off the Amplifier Ensure the amplifier is turned off before connecting or disconnecting any fibers or plugs to prevent damage or unstable output .
- Prepare the Amplifier and Fibers
- Mount the amplifier on a DIN rail if required.
- Fit any attachments to the fiber cables before inserting them into the amplifier .
- Insert Fiber Cables
- Identify the beam-emitting inlet (usually labeled “P”) for the single-core fiber and the beam-receiving inlet for the multi-core fiber.
- Insert the fibers slowly until they stop. Avoid bending flexible fibers inside the amplifier, as this can reduce sensing accuracy .
- Snap the fiber lock lever down to secure the fibers, then return it to its original position until it stops .
- Connect the End Plug (Quick-Connection Cable)
- Use the optional quick-connection cable supplied for the amplifier type.
- Insert the connector into the amplifier until a click is felt. Do not use cables with broken projections, and avoid pulling the cable by the wire to prevent damage
