

How to connect the ground wire of a three-level distribution box

The ground wire of a three-level distribution box should be connected to the PE (protective earth) bar inside the box, and all metallic components should be bonded to this bar to ensure proper grounding.

Step-by-Step Grounding Procedure

1. Locate the PE Bar: Open the distribution box and identify the grounding bar, often marked as "PE" or with a grounding symbol. This is the designated point for connecting all ground wires inside the box . 2. Connect the Main Ground Wire: Strip the insulation from the end of the main ground wire from the power supply and securely attach it to the PE bar using the terminal screw. Ensure the connection is tight to prevent loosening over time . 3. Bond Internal Components: Any metallic parts or electrical components inside the distribution box that require grounding should be connected to the PE bar using copper wires. This ensures that all parts share the same ground potential, reducing the risk of electric shock or equipment damage . 4. Connect to External Grounding System: The PE bar should also be connected to the building's central grounding system or grounding electrode. This provides a safe path for fault currents and maintains system safety . 5. Use Proper Wire Specifications: Use a yellow-green insulated copper wire with a cross-sectional area that meets local electrical codes (typically at least 6 mm² for industrial applications or 10 AWG in the US). This ensures low resistance and effective grounding . 6. Verify Grounding: After installation, measure the resistance between the PE bar and the external grounding point. It should be less than 0.1 ohm to ensu...
