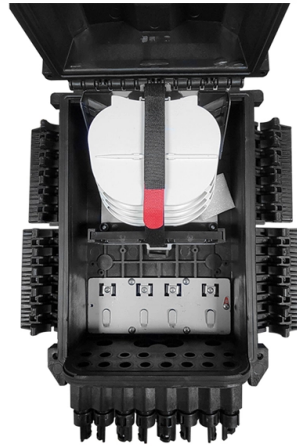


How to connect the incoming line of the circuit breaker in the distribution box



Article Overview

The incoming line of a circuit breaker should be connected to the line terminals of the main breaker, which then feeds the busbars distributing power to individual breakers.

Main Breaker Connection

The incoming service conductors from the meter or utility supply—typically two hot wires (for 240V split-phase) and a neutral—should be connected to the line side of the main breaker. The hot wires attach to the main breaker lugs, which then energize the busbars inside the panel, while the neutral wire connects to the neutral busbar, which is bonded to the grounding system for safety .

Busbars and Branch Circuits

The main breaker distributes power to the hot busbars, which supply individual branch circuit breakers. For 120V circuits, a single-pole breaker connects one hot busbar to the load. For 240V circuits, a double-pole breaker connects to both hot busbars . The neutral bar provides a return path for current and is connected to the grounding bar to ensure proper fault protection .

Line vs Load Orientation

Circuit breakers are designed with a preferred line side, usually marked as "LINE." The incoming power must be connected to this side. Connecting the source to the l...
