

How to determine if it s an OM3 fiber optic cable

You can identify an OM3 fiber optic cable by checking its jacket color, print legend, core/cladding size, and verifying performance with optical testing tools.

1. Check the Jacket Color

OM3 cables are typically aqua-colored, which distinguishes them from OM1/OM2 (orange) and OM4 (aqua or heather violet) fibers. While color is a helpful first clue, it is not definitive because manufacturers may vary the jacket color .

2. Inspect the Print Legend

Look for printed markings along the cable jacket. OM3 cables are usually labeled with “OM3” and may include additional specifications such as fiber count, core/cladding size (50/125 μm), and performance ratings. This is the most reliable method to confirm the fiber type .

3. Measure Core and Cladding

OM3 is a 50 μm core / 125 μm cladding multimode fiber. Using a microscope or fiber inspection tool, you can verify these dimensions. OM1 has a 62.5 μm core, and OM2 also has a 50 μm core but lower bandwidth, so this measurement helps differentiate OM3 from other multimode fibers
