How to do it correctly: Use a lint-free cleaning stick or high-density IPA swab moistened with anhydrous isopropyl alcohol (IPA) at ≥ 99 . Push the swab through the groove in a single direction, following the groove's axis. This guide walks through a professional cleaning and maintenance routine for fiber optic fusion splicers: what to do daily, what to schedule periodically, and which well-meaning shortcuts will quietly destroy your equipment. This ensures safety for the operator and equipment, and. The good news is that the process required to guarantee a perfectly clean splice is extremely straightforward and quick to perform.
