

How to ground a distribution box that has no socket



Overview

The most common and simplest solution for an ungrounded circuit is to install a Ground-Fault Circuit Interrupter (GFCI) device. Electrical grounding is a fundamental safety mechanism that provides a low-resistance route for fault current to return to the source and trip a circuit breaker or fuse. This pathway prevents metal casings of appliances and tools from becoming energized with hazardous voltage during an internal. How do we get that ground to the receptacle itself?
