

How to ground the wires in a high-voltage distribution box



Article Overview

The ground wire of a high-voltage distribution box should be securely connected to the PE or grounding bar using appropriately sized copper wire, ensuring all metal parts are bonded and the system complies with NEC and local grounding standards.

Steps for Grounding a High-Voltage Distribution Box

1. Identify the Grounding Point Open the distribution box and locate the grounding bar (PE bar) or the position marked for grounding. This is the main connection point for the ground wire inside the box . 2. Select the Proper Ground Wire Use a yellow-green insulated copper wire with a cross-sectional area meeting or exceeding code requirements. For medium- and high-voltage systems, the NEC specifies minimum sizes based on the overcurrent protective device rating, and grounding conductors must be sized according to Section 250.122 . In some industrial applications, a 6 mm² or 10 AWG wire may be used depending on the market . 3. Connect the Ground Wire

- Strip the insulation for the required length.
- Attach the wire to the PE bar or threaded stud using a secure terminal and tighten the screw firmly.
- If there are electrical components inside the box, connect them to the PE bar to ensure all noncurrent-carrying metal parts are grounded . 4. Bonding and Resistance Considerations
- Ensure the ground resistance between all system parts is below 0.1 Ohm for proper safety
