

How to hang fiber optic cables on power poles and their prices



Article Overview

Fiber optic cables can be installed on poles using self-supporting or lashed methods, with costs ranging from \$15,000 to \$33,000 per mile depending on cable type and installation method.

Types of Aerial Fiber Optic Cables

- ADSS (All-Dielectric Self-Supporting) Cable: Strong, self-supporting cable that can span long distances (up to 1000 meters) without additional support. Ideal for areas without existing messenger wires and can be installed near power lines safely .
- Figure-8 or Messenger-Lashed Cable: Uses a steel messenger wire for support. The fiber is lashed to the messenger wire and is suitable for routes with existing pole infrastructure .
- Loose Tube or Light Armored Cable: Often used for cable rack installations or secondary trunk lines. Requires additional support hardware when installed aerially .

Installation Methods

- Stand and Lash Method:
 - Temporary supports or blocks are installed at each pole.
 - A pull line is threaded through the supports and attached to the cable.
 - The cable is pulled into position using a winch or manually, ensuring tension does not exceed the maximum rated cable load.
 - Cable is then lashed to the messenger wire and tensioned to achieve proper sag .
