

How to install fireproof partitions for electrical distribution boxes

Fireproof partitions for electrical distribution boxes can be installed using UL-listed firestop products, intumescent putty pads, or certified fire-resistant enclosures to maintain the wall's fire-resistance rating.

Key Steps for Installation

1. Assess the Wall and Box Requirements Determine the fire-resistance rating of the wall or partition (e.g., F30/F90) and the type of electrical box (metallic or non-metallic, recessed or surface-mounted). The installation must ensure that the fire rating of the wall is not compromised by the penetration of the box . 2. Select Certified Firestop Materials Use UL-listed or tested firestop products such as:

- Intumescent putty pads: Soft, moldable sheets applied around the box; they expand under heat to seal gaps .
 - Firestop box inserts or gaskets: Designed to fit inside or around the box to prevent fire spread .
 - Endothermic mats: Absorb heat and protect the wall assembly. Ensure the product is certified for the specific box size and wall type, and follow the manufacturer's installation instructions.
3. Apply Firestop Products Correctly
- For metallic boxes ≤ 16 sq in, apply putty pads to the back and sides of the box away from studs .
 - For larger boxes or non-metallic boxes, use listed firestop inserts or enclosures as specified in the product listing
