

How to lay fiber optic cable on a fiber optic reel



Article Overview

Properly laying fiber optic cable from a reel requires careful handling, monitoring tension, and maintaining minimum bend radius to prevent damage.

Preparation and Inspection

Before laying the cable, inspect the reel and cable for damage, ensure the plastic wrap is intact, and verify that the cable type, length, and fiber count match the installation plan . Wear protective gloves and steel-toed boots when handling reels, as they can be heavy . Check that all reel bolts are tight and that the inside of the flanges is free of objects that could damage the cable . Seal cable ends with pre-formed or heat-shrinkable end caps to prevent contamination .

Positioning the Reel

Place the reel in line with the intended direction of deployment to avoid rubbing against the reel flanges . Use a cable reel stand or rotatable drum to allow smooth unspooling. Ensure the reel rotates freely and, if available, use a tension-controlled puller to prevent excessive pulling force .

Unspooling the Cable

- Pull, do not push the cable to avoid exceeding the minimum bend radius .
- Avoid twisting the cable; always roll it off the spool rather than spinning it from th...
