Protective Coatings

These create a barrier between the metal surface and corrosive elements. Zinc-rich coatings, for example, oxidize before the steel, providing sacrificial protection. Coating thickness and adhesion are critical; excessive thickness can reduce load capacity, while poor adhesion can lead to cracking or flaking
