

How to use a fusion splice pigtail in a terminal box



Article Overview

To connect a terminal box and a pigtail, feed the fiber into the box, prepare the fiber ends, fusion splice the pigtail to the incoming fiber, protect the splice, and route the fibers neatly in the tray.

Step 1: Prepare Tools and Materials

Ensure you have the following ready: a fusion splicer, fiber stripper, precision cleaver, heat-shrink splice protection sleeves, lint-free wipes, 99% isopropyl alcohol, cable ties, and an OTDR or power meter for testing. Keep all tools clean and calibrated to avoid splice loss ().

Step 2: Prepare the Terminal Box

- Mount the terminal box securely at the installation site.
- Install SC adapters or couplers into the box.
- Feed the incoming optical cable into the box, leaving 15–20 cm of slack for termination.
- Strip the outer jacket and expose the strength members according to the cable design ().

Step 3: Prepare the Pigtail

- Slide a heat-shrink splice protection sleeve onto the pigtail before stripping....
