Standard cable tray dimensions vary by type, with widths from 6 to 48 inches, heights from 25mm to 150mm, and lengths typically 12 to 30 feet, with rung spacing from 6 to 18 inches depending on cable type.

Standard Widths and Heights

Cable tray widths are standardized to accommodate different cable volumes and installation requirements. Ladder-type trays commonly come in widths of 6, 9, 12, 18, 24, 30, 36, 42, and 48 inches, while heights generally range from 25mm to 150mm, depending on cable fill and ventilation needs . Ventilated or solid-bottom trays may have slightly different height ranges to ensure proper heat dissipation and cable support .

Rung Spacing

Rung spacing is critical for supporting cables without sagging. For small-diameter control and instrumentation cables, 6, 9, or 12-inch spacing is recommended, while larger power cables require 9 inches or wider . Wider spacing reduces overall tray strength, so load capacity must be considered when selecting tray width and rung spacing.

Lengths and Support Spans

Standard cable tray lengths follow NEMA guidelines: 12, 20, 24, and 30 feet, with some manufacturers offering lengths up to 40 feet . Support intervals vary by span...
