

Installation height of residential indoor electrical distribution box



Article Overview

The recommended installation height for a household indoor distribution box is typically between 1.4 meters and 1.8 meters (4.5 to 5.9 feet) from the floor.

Recommended Height

For residential settings, wall-mounted distribution boxes should be installed at a height of approximately 1.4 to 1.7 meters (4.5 to 5.5 feet) to ensure easy access without excessive bending or stretching, while keeping the box safe from accidental impacts or water spills . Some guidelines suggest a maximum height of 1.8 meters to facilitate operation and maintenance . For elderly or disabled individuals, a slightly lower height of around 1.3 meters may be more suitable .

Safety and Accessibility Considerations

- Dry and ventilated location: The box should be installed in a dry area away from sinks, bathrooms, or other wet locations to prevent electrical hazards .
- Clear working space: Adequate space around the box is necessary for safe access and maintenance, as specified in BS 7671 and IEC 61439 standards .
- Secure mounting: Use proper mounting hardware such as expansion bolts to ensure the box is firmly affixed to the wall .
- Avoid excessive height: Installing the box too high can make operation difficult and unsafe, especially during emergencies
