

Installation of pigtails on a 12-core fusion splice tray



Article Overview

To install pigtails on a 12-core fusion splice tray, each fiber must be carefully stripped, cleaved, fusion-spliced, color-matched, and secured within the tray using proper bend radius and protection sleeves.

Preparation and Tools

Before starting, ensure you have the following tools and materials: a fusion splicer, fiber strippers, a high-precision cleaver, lint-free wipes, 99% isopropyl alcohol, and heat-shrink splice protection sleeves . Using high-quality tools is critical to prevent fiber damage and ensure low-loss splices.

Pigtail and Fiber Preparation

A 12-core pigtail consists of 12 color-coded fibers with factory-polished connectors on one end and bare fibers on the other . Strip the protective coating from the bare ends of both the pigtail and the incoming trunk fibers, then clean them thoroughly until they are free of oils and debris . Cleave each fiber to a precise 90-degree angle using a high-precision cleaver to ensure a seamless fusion.

Fusion Splicing

Insert the prepared fibers into the fusion splicer and align them according to the splicer's instructions. For a 12-core ribbon, you can perform mass fusion splicing, fu...
