Data is recorded as patterns of pits or marks on the disc surface, which can be read back by a laser. These devices are considered secondary storage media, capable of holding data ranging from hundreds of megabytes to tens of gigabytes depending on the format. Optical storage devices are removable and retain data even when powered off, unlike optical modules, which only facilitate signal transmission.
