An optical cable can be considered a national standard cable if it meets the specifications set by recognized national or regional standards bodies, often based on international standards.

Understanding Optical Cable Standards

Optical cables are governed by both international and national standards to ensure performance, reliability, and interoperability. Key international standards include:

- ITU-T G.65x series: Defines single-mode fiber types such as G.652, G.655, and G.657, specifying optical and geometrical characteristics for telecommunications applications .
- IEC 60793 and IEC 60794: Cover fiber and cable specifications, including mechanical and environmental performance .
- ISO/IEC 11801: Addresses structured cabling systems for commercial and industrial premises . National standards often adopt or adapt these international standards. For example:
 - TIA/EIA standards in the US: Provide minimum performance requirements for fiber optic cabling, structured cabling, and installation practices .
 - ETSI in Europe: Defines telecommunications standards for optical fibers and networks, aligning with international guidelines while addressing regional requirements .
