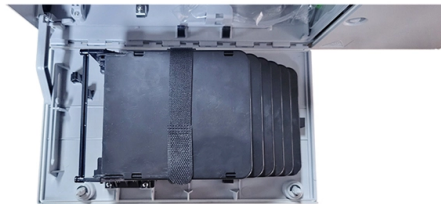


Is it permissible to make bends in cable trays yourself



Article Overview

Field bends in cable trays are technically possible, but self-made bends may violate NEC and UL compliance unless done according to manufacturer guidelines and proper fittings.

Regulatory Considerations

Under NEC Article 392, metallic cable trays can be bent in the field, but the bends must maintain the tray's structural integrity, smooth edges, and grounding path. Simply cutting and manually bending a tray without proper fittings can compromise these requirements and may fail inspection or void UL certification, as UL does not guarantee safety for field-modified parts (CableOrganizer.com) .

Manufacturer Guidelines

Most manufacturers provide pre-fabricated bends of various radii for ladder, basket, or wire mesh trays. Using these ensures compliance with minimum bend radius and maintains cable protection. If a manufacturer specifies a minimum radius, it must be followed to prevent damage to cables and maintain NEC compliance (MikeHolt.com) .
