What is an OLT?

An Optical Line Terminal (OLT) is the central device in a Passive Optical Network (PON) that connects the service provider's backbone to multiple customer endpoints. It converts electrical signals into optical signals, manages bandwidth, and coordinates communication with Optical Network Units (ONUs) or Terminals (ONTs) at subscriber locations, effectively acting as the “brain” of a fiber network . OLTs can support various PON standards, including GPON, XGS-PON, and EPON, and can connect dozens of subscribers per port depending on the split ratio .

What is PAM4?

PAM4 (Pulse Amplitude Modulation with 4 levels) is a modulation scheme that encodes two bits per symbol using four distinct amplitude levels, effectively doubling the data rate compared to traditional NRZ (non-return-to-zero) modulation . PAM4 enables high-speed transmission, such as 400G or 800G, over short distances (typically up to 10 km), making it ideal for dense urban fiber networks and data center interconnects . While PAM4 increases bandwidth efficiency, it requires more advanced signal processing, forward error correction (FEC), and higher-performing...
