Grounding Basics

A lighting distribution box must be grounded to prevent electric shock and protect equipment. Grounding involves connecting the metal parts of the box and any internal electrical components to a grounding bar (PE bar) or a designated grounding point inside the box using a copper wire. The ground wire provides a low-resistance path for fault currents to safely dissipate into the earth.

Wire Selection

- Use copper core wire for grounding, as it offers excellent conductivity and durability.
- The wire should be yellow-green insulated for easy identification and safety.
- The cross-sectional area must meet or exceed the specifications for your system; for example, in the US, a 10 AWG wire is commonly used for distribution boxes.

Connection Steps

- Locate the grounding bar or PE bar inside the distribution box. This is usually marked with "PE" or a grounding symbol.
- Connect the power supply ground wire directly to the PE bar. Strip the wire to the appropriate length, insert it into the terminal, and tighten the screw securely to ensure a firm connection
