Terminal distribution boxes are typically installed in accessible, dry, and ventilated areas such as basements, utility rooms, garages, or industrial control panels, with terminal blocks mounted inside for organized wiring.

Typical Locations

- **Residential Settings:** Distribution boxes (also called electrical panels or breaker boxes) are usually found in the basement, garage, utility room, or mounted outside near the electrical meter. They should be positioned where power lines enter the home and in areas that are dry, ventilated, and free from flammable or corrosive substances .
- **Commercial and Industrial Settings:** Larger distribution boxes are often installed in control rooms, electrical closets, or machinery enclosures. They must be easily accessible for maintenance and inspection while being protected from dust, moisture, and vibration .

Terminal Block Placement

- **Inside Distribution Boxes:** Terminal blocks are mounted on DIN rails or directly on the panelboard inside the distribution box. This allows for neat wiring, easy troubleshooting, and safe connections .
- **Safety Considerations:** Terminal blocks should be clearly labeled, insulated, and positioned to avoid water, dust, or mechanical stress. Adequate clearance around the distribution box (at least 3 feet in front) is required to allow safe access and operation
