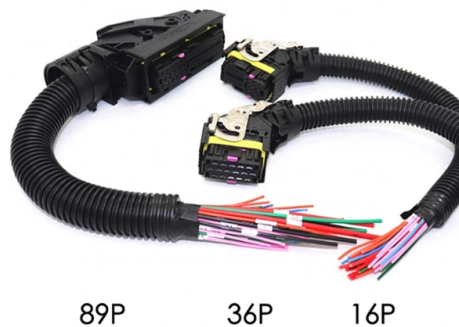


Measure the length of vertical optical cable

Optical fiber length can be accurately measured using specialized tools like optical fiber length meters, visual optical length testers, or OTDRs, providing precise end-to-end measurements without relying on jacket markings.

Methods for Measuring Fiber Length

1. Optical Fiber Length Meters (OFLM) Devices like the OZ Optics OFLM-1000 measure fiber length with high precision, offering resolution better than 2 mm and repeatability under 3 mm for distances up to 500 meters. The system works by sending light through the fiber and calculating the optical path length, which can then be logged to a computer for documentation. Accuracy depends on the fiber's refractive index, which must be calibrated for the specific fiber type. For short fibers under 1 meter, a patch cord of known length is used to set a base length for measurement . 2. Visual Optical Length Testers (VOLT) The VOLT uses a “round-robin” method, where two fibers are looped back at one end of the cable. The device measures the round-trip time of light through the fibers and converts it to length, dividing by two to determine the cable's end-to-end length. This method works for singlemode and multimode fibers up to 1.5 kilometers and provides accuracy within ± 2.5 meters. The VOLT also functions as a visual fault locator, allowing simultaneous identification of breaks or splices . 3. Optical Time Domain Reflectometers (OTDRs) OTDRs are widely used for field measurements, especially for pre- and post-construction testing. They send pulses of light into the fiber and measure backscattered signals to determine distance to events such as splices or faults. Usi...
