

Measuring fiber optic cables with red light source



Article Overview

A red light source, typically a Visual Fault Locator (VFL), can be used to detect breaks, bends, or continuity issues in fiber optic cables by shining visible red light through the fiber.

Tools Required

- Visual Fault Locator (VFL): Emits a red light, usually around 650 nm wavelength, visible through the fiber jacket .
- Fiber optic connectors and adapters: Ensure proper connection between the VFL and the fiber.
- Cleaning supplies: To clean connectors and prevent signal loss due to dirt or scratches .

Step-by-Step Procedure

- Inspect and Clean Connectors: Check for dirt, scratches, or cracks on the fiber connectors and clean them to ensure accurate testing .
- Connect the VFL: Attach the VFL to one end of the fiber optic cable. Ensure a secure connection to prevent light leakage .
- Observe the Fiber: Look at the opposite end of the fiber or along the cable. If the fiber is intact, the red light should be visible at the far end. Any breaks, sharp bends, or poor splices will cause the light to escape, highlighting the fault location .
- Document Findings: Note the locations of any visible faults for repair or further testing
