

Method for saving optical cable test data

Saving Test Data

- **Internal Memory:** Most OTDRs and fiber test devices allow you to save results directly to the device's internal memory. This is useful for on-site review and quick access without additional hardware .
- **USB or External Storage:** You can connect a USB drive or external storage device to the tester and export results. This method is ideal for transferring data to a computer for detailed analysis or archiving .
- **Cloud Storage:** Some modern OTDRs support cloud-based storage, enabling real-time access to test results from any location. This is particularly useful for teams working across multiple sites or for centralized data management .

Exporting Test Data

- **File Formats:** Test results can typically be exported in PDF for reporting purposes, CSV for spreadsheet analysis, or proprietary formats compatible with the manufacturer's software .
- **Export Process:** Select the test result, choose the export option (USB, email, cloud), pick the desired format, and save to the chosen destination. This ensures data is backed up and easily shareable .
